### Anemone 'Honorine Jobert'

Discovered in 1858 in Verdun, France, this fall-blooming anemone remains an outstanding selection. Honorine Jobert is a vigorous, compact cultivar featuring large, snow white flowers with yellow center stamens borne on long, graceful, branching stems above an attractive mound of dark green leaves. Blooms in September.

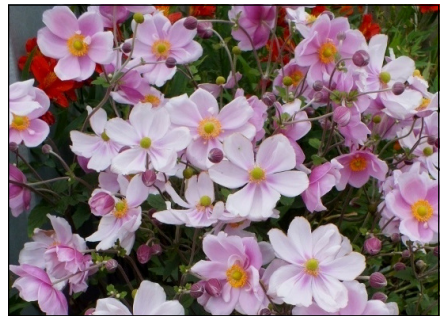

Attracts and feeds Monarch butterflies.

Astrantia is a wonderful woodland plant preferring moist, shady areas rich in organic matter. A clump-forming perennial with masses of palm-shaped leaves, Astrantias bloom early to late summer. Wiry stems rise above the foliage, each tipped with a rounded flower head, set in a cup of colorful, star-shaped bracts. Star of Fire features clusters of burgundy red flowers with white centers accented by dark purple stems. This vigorous grower is floriferous with long-lasting blooms. Excellent cut and dried flowers.

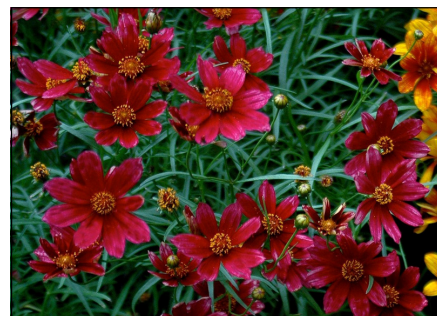

Spring is the peak ornamental time for this plant! Newly emerging, sword-shaped, green leaves are variegated with bright cream striping. Yellow blooms (2-5" across) with brown markings on the falls are borne on rigid, upright stems. Leaf variegation tends to fade by summer and plant height is directly proportional to the amount of soil moisture. Great near the water's edge.

The flower shape resembles a Japanese iris because of its broad falls. Clumps will grow together and snuff out weeds. Excellent cut flower, but lasts only 2 days.

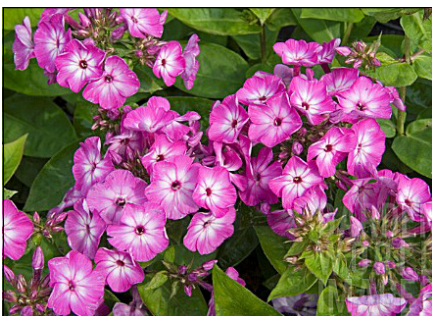
